Hello My Little Sheepies – We are one month into a New Year! So, how are you all holding up?

Our Bishop Bruce Ough has retired. I will certainly miss him and his Wife Char. I have served (as Pastor) under two Bishops – Bishop Sally Dyck (who appointed me to Balaton) and Bishop Bruce Ough.

Both equally good in leadership. When I was State Youth Coordinator, I got to know Bishop John Hopkins fairly well too. I liked him a lot. When I was a teenager, and served on our Southwest District Youth Team, Bishop Emerson Colaw was our MN Bishop. I had met him at a youth event and had a wonderful conversation with him about "Life and Faith". He impacted me so! Years later, I had the opportunity to tell him that while we both were attending Jurisdictional Conference. All to say I value our Episcopal (fancy word meaning Bishop) leadership.

Our interim Bishop is David Bard who serves as Bishop for our Michigan Conference. Bishop Bard is a "Homegrown Minnesotan" who has served Duluth UMC, as well as District Superintendent. I've worked with David ... and he knows how Minnesota United Methodists function. He knows our pulse and heart. He will serve us well during this "In between space" before electing a new Bishop this Fall.

Bishop Bard has moved us to the "ORANGE PHASE" – still advising much caution in regard to COVID19 and our churches, preferable online worship only, yet recognizing that this has been and is a tiring journey, and "One Model Does Not Fit All" Congregations.

We will be opening our Sanctuary for IN PERSON WORSHIP again on Sunday, February 7th

9am. With an abundance of caution – masks will be required, not optional, physical distancing (spread out), use hand sanitizer upon entry and exit, singing under mask to music on the screen is ok. We are going to try in person again with the understanding that if you aren't comfortable with being present ... it is A-Ok. The SERMON will still be available online by 9am. WORSHIP BAGS will continue to be delivered on Saturday. If Sunday attendance falls below 12 present ... we'll just go online only. It simply doesn't merit to heat the Sanctuary for just a very small group.

<u>CONFIRMATION</u> – has also resumed to IN PERSON on Wednesday nights. This past Wednesday we were back in session. Good to be back! We have about 23 teenagers between the three churches, a couple of adults who

help, Vicar Rick and myself. We are digging into the Ten Commandments in depth, taking cues from the movie *"Bruce Almighty"*. We had a really great discussion this week. Any interested adults are always welcome to sit in.

JAM FACEBOOK LIVE – Wednesdays 6pm. We've had some issues with Facebook taking down our music due to copyright infringement. Even with our Streaming License, this happens. Vicar Rick and I will be offering 5:30pm Weekly half hour worship services alternating between Trinity and Sillerud …. Methodists are more than welcomed and encouraged to join in. ASH WEDNESDAY worship will be 5:30pm at TRINITY with Imposition of ashes by Vicar Rick and PL using masks, gloves, and Q-Tips (disposing of the Qtip after each person).

We have adjusted the JAM Facebook Live and Confirmation times slightly during Lent to accommodate this half hour service. We are trying our best to navigate LENT while still being cautious. Be gentle.
