STUDY QUESTIONS:

1) What dream/nightmare has inspired or haunted you? What is Cornelius like? (vs. 1-2) Since he is part of an occupying army, what is so unusual about his encounter with God? How does Cornelius' life challenge you?

2) As a child, what foods did you refuse to eat? What foods do you still dislike today? Look at Leviticus 11:4-7, 13-19, 29-30 – with these restrictions, how do you think Peter felt when he heard the voice ordering him to eat these animals? Why was it repeated 3xs? Verse 15 – How does this fit the story of Cornelius? 3) What principles or beliefs do you hold that limit your ability to reach out to people "different" from you? What new relationships has God given you recently? Jews regarded even people like Cornelius as "pagans" unless they submitted fully to Jewish practices (see 11:3), so what would it have meant to Cornelius for Peter to not only enter his home, but to eat & stay with him? 4) As you were growing up, were there any certain groups/people that you were told not to associate with? Would family & friends describe you as open or closed minded? If God gave you a vision about your attitude toward other people ... what would he tell you?
